This is a hand-wound chronograph-timer which enables hourly averages to be calculated. It is essential for engineers, technical managers, calculators, motorists and all sportsmen who wish to ascertain precise times.

The dial includes 2 registers and a tachometric scale.

On the right, a register counts up to 30 minutes.

At the bottom, a register counts up to 12 hours.

On the left, a small dial continuously marks the seconds.

As the minute-register does not go beyond 30 minutes, any longer observation must be made by reading first the time shown by the hour-register and then that shown by the minute-register. It is also necessary to take into account the number of seconds shown by the large central-seconds hand.

The tachometric scale indicates the speed of a vehicle in kilometres or miles per hour if the observer takes a basic distance of 1000 metres or one mile, respectively. In this case, the speed is given directly by the tachometric scale.



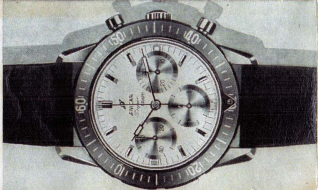
